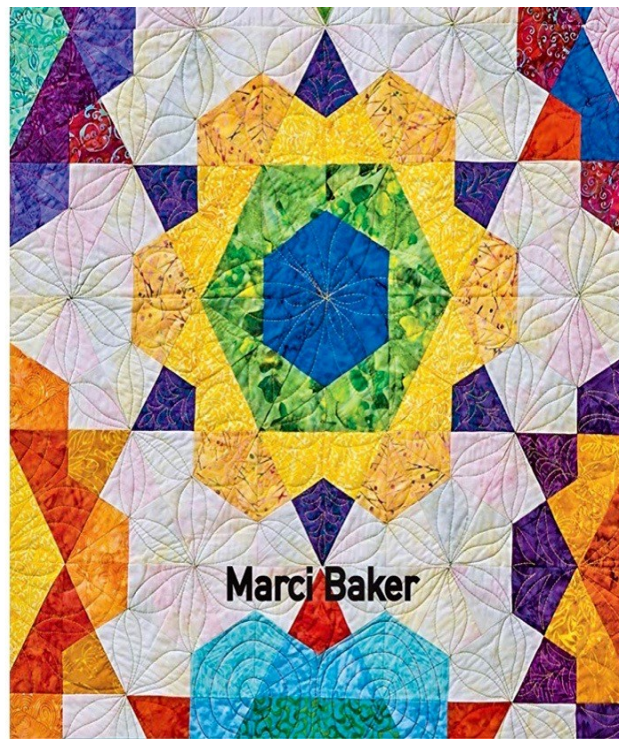

Birthplace of rivers

Throughout the history of Pocahontas County rivers played an important part in economical, social, and ecological fabric of the region.

Log drives were the high points of the year for farm families living along the Greenbrier River. They provided excitement of seeing the river choked with logs and also a chance to sell fresh eggs and meat to the loggers for a bit of cash.

Today the Greenbrier River is the longest free flowing river in the East and provides recreation for thousands of visitors. The Elk River along with the Williams and Cranberry are an important part of the ecosystem of the region. Fishermen's tales of the "big one" out of the Williams River are plentiful and we suspect little exaggerated.

Completing the list of eight rivers whose beginnings lie in Pocahontas County are the Cherry, Shaver Fork of the Cheat, Tygart, and Gauley.

Other important waterways include the creeks Knapp's, Deer, Stamping, Locust, and Sitlington, along with other smaller creeks and runs.

Formerly known as the Pearl S Buck Quilting Party held in Hillsboro, WV. The Eight Rivers Quilting Party was organized in August 2015.

The Eight Rivers group will meet at the McClintic Library in Marlinton. The goal of our group is to learn new quilting techniques and patterns, share our common interest in Primitive art form and enjoy both the friendships and atmosphere of our beautiful Pocahontas County area.

Our program consists of three one-day workshops with experienced teachers for both learning and quilting experiences. Registration is open for one or more classes by returning the attached registration form with your check by July 15, 2019. Our classes are limited in size due to necessary workspace, teacher-student ratio and on advanced beginner or intermediate accomplished levels.

Workshop Schedules are as follows:

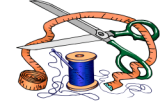
August 1 Thursday	Covered Bridge Wallhanging

We are listing class fees, patterns and kits (if desired) on our registration form. Please include these fees with your registration. A supply list will be sent to you upon registration. You may use fabric from your own "stash" if desired. All classes require you bring your own sewing machine in good working order and bring your manual along in the event of problems.

Registration for classes must be received by July 15, 2019. Refunds will be made until July 25, 2019 if you must cancel. A waiting list will be compiled if needed on a first come first serve basis. We suggest you register early as these classes fill up quickly.

Bring your own brown bag lunch or visit nearby restaurant or store. Refreshments will be available for breaks. Coffee, tea and bottled water will be provided.

This class will help develop new paper piecing skills while making a wall hanging of a covered bridge 19 1/2" X 17 1/2", allowing you to check your "stash" for necessary fabrics. This method does not require you to cut paper or sew through the paper thus saving your needles, rotary cutter and scissors a lot.

Log Cabin Star Table Mat

Skill Level—Intermediate

Tuition: \$25.00 Pattern \$5.00

This class is an adaptation of the basic Log Cabin quilt block that uses a dark focus fabric and a light background fabric. The goal for our class is for all class participants to complete this project prior to leaving for the day. If the fabrics are precut according to the provided instructions, before class begins, the resulting top can be complete in one day. The completed mat will be a 28 1/2" X 28 1/2". There will also be examples of other block adaption of the basic log cabin concept shown and discussed.

Betty has been piecing and quilting for 20+ years. She has also developed an interest in free motion quilting on a domestic home sewing machine and then designed free motion classes that she has taught in the Alderson Quilters and Crafters Retreats and past Pearl S. Buck Quilting Parties. A retired teacher, Betty lives in Lowell, WV with yards of fabric and her understanding husband.

Have you stayed away from patterns with the dreaded "Y" seams?? Fear no more, Marci Baker is ingenious with this simple no fuss "Y" seam. Michelle has an easy way to show you too. Whether you are making one block or 50 blocks this will change your mind and you will be glad you signed up. Great using jelly rolls and scrappy fabric in stashes. Go thru your stash for 2 1/2" X WOF to make Pretty Rose Petals. Batiks will work fabulously or 4 romantic fabric will be sweet. Make sure you have a complementary background to go with the good coordinating mix of lights, mediums and darks of jelly roll strips or from your own fabrics. Project will be lap size.
